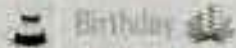

Kalpana Chawla was an American astronaut and the first woman of Indian origin in space.

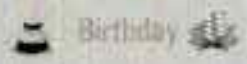
Mangal Pandey was an Indian soldier who played a key part in events immediately preceding the outbreak of the Indian rebellion of 1857.

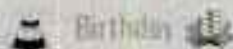
Achievements

Vikram Ambalal Sarabhai was an Indian scientist and innovator widely regarded as the father of India's space programme.

In 1971, she was awarded the first Pope John XXIII Peace Prize for her work with the poor, display of Christian charity and efforts for peace. In 1979, Mother Teresa was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize, "for work undertaken in the struggle to overcome poverty and distress, which also constitutes a threat to peace." Canonized on 4th September 2016 at Saint Peter's Square, Vatican City by Pope Francis.
